Biographies

Clare Waters (guitar)

Clare Waters graduated from the UWA Conservatorium of Music in 2023 with a Bachelor of Philosophy and First Class Honours in Music. She studied with Catherine Cahill, Dr Ashley Smith, and WASO principal clarinetist Allan Meyer.

Clare is currently the principal clarinetist of the Darwin Symphony Orchestra, having commenced the position in 2025. The orchestra recently completed a tour of the Northern Territory through Katherine, Tennant Creek, and Alice Springs, performing with local artists and delivering education workshops to local students.

During her degree, Clare was the recipient of the Wesley Uniting Church Scholarship in 2020, and the WA Youth Orchestra Peter Moore OAM Scholarship in 2022. Clare has performed with numerous ensembles around Perth, including as principal clarinet in the WA Youth Orchestra, the WA Wind Symphony, and the UWA Wind, Chamber, and Symphony Orchestras. She has also had the opportunity to perform alongside the WA Symphony Orchestra in collaboration with WAYO, and has been involved in other collaborations with WA Opera, the Orchestra Collective, the Irwin Street Collective, and the Darlington String Quartet.

Alongside her performance commitments, Clare is a passionate teacher, and currently teaches clarinet at three schools in Perth, which she balances with flying to and from Darwin once a week during concert seasons.

Adrian Soares (piano)

Adrian is a seasoned and versatile performer and educator, graduating from UWA with First Class Honours in 2019. While at UWA, he was awarded the prestigious Tunley Music Scholarship, VOSE Memorial Concerto Prize, Waveney Wansborough Memorial Prize and Flora Bunning Chamber Music Prize. Adrian also received the Lady Callaway Award from the Australian Society of Music Education (ASME) in recognition for outstanding service as an accompanist in the field of music education.

Adrian works as a piano tutor, accompanist and contemporary band coordinator for Iona Presentation College, and as a freelance collaborative pianist for many ensembles and musicians in Perth, including West Australian Symphony Orchestra, Perth Symphony Orchestra, WA Young Voices, Freeze Frame Opera, WAAPA and UWA. Adrian is also in high demand as an arranger, and is regularly involved in the music theatre scene as a music director and keyboardist for both professional and school productions.
